I (Glenn Penner) came across a photocopy of [emigration applications for the months of January to May 1929](#) in the Mennonite Heritage Archives (Winnipeg). These were obtained in 1996 by the archivist at the time, Lawrence Klippenstein.

Very few of these applications were successful. Some were able to flee at the end of World War II, some, or their children, were able to leave after the fall of the communist state, and a few simply disappeared.

Note that for most applicants, there is a short physical description!

These applications mention additional documents, such as photos and certificates produced by the applicants. It is possible that these are also in the Zaporizhzhia archives.
