

Baptismal Records for the Mennonite Congregation of Deutsch Kazun, Poland 1834-1943

The original church records for Deutsch Kazun were destroyed in 1939. A new register was started around that year. Deaths and birth go back only to 1916. These are found on LDS film 1053154. Originals are in the Mennonite Historical Society of British Columbia (MHSBC) archives, Abbotsford, BC and are being transcribed by the MHSBC.

Fortunately, the Deutsch Kazun baptismal list started in 1834 was copied in 1902 and continued until 1943. Originals of these are in the MHSBC archives, Abbotsford, BC. They are also found on LDS film 1053154. It appears that, at this time (April 2015), only scattered entries have been incorporated into the GRANDMA (GM) database.
