This file contains extensive information about the area around the Mennonite Settlement of Deutsch Kazun (Kazuń Niemiecki, later known as Kazuń Nowy). Included in this file is a list of the "Holedrow" (Dutch) landowners in "Kazun". Note that this does not mean that these people were Dutch or Mennonite. It refers to the type of village structure used by Germanic settlers in Poland. The list accounts for a total of 97 people. There were likely other Mennonites who were not landowners as well as those who lived in nearby villages.

Surname - is a standardized surname for those who appear to be Mennonites

Name - is the name as it appears in the original document

H = husbands

W = wives

S = Sons

D = Daughters

MS = male servants (presumably Mennonite)

FS = female servants (presumably Mennonite)
