## Molotschna Settlement Property Transfers: 1843

## State Archives of Dnipro Region (DADO), Dnipro, Ukraine Fond 6 Inventory 1 File 7208

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The following table contains information on the property transfers that took place within the Molotschna Mennonite Settlement during the first half of 1843. This is not a concise exact translation. I have essentially summarized the original German entries in English. Additional information not shown in the table is 1) all properties were free of state debt at the time of sale, 2) currency is in Silver Rubles, and 3) all new owners did not previously own property. Although the entries do not explicitly say so, many of the new owners were registered in their father's households in the previous (1835) census.

It should be noted that some of the previous owners were forced to sell by the <u>Agricultural Association</u>, under the leadership of <u>Johann Cornies</u>. Just who sold under their own volition and who was forced to do so is not stated anywhere in this file. The Johann Cornies correspondence occasionally gives this information. Much of this correspondence has been translated and published in the following books:
