The Schlachtin Mennonite Settlement was founded in 1872 by Mennonites of the Chortitza settlement. There is very little published history on this settlement. The [GAMEO](#) article provides almost nothing.

It is likely that the Chortitza settlement purchased land on behalf of those intending to settle in the Schlachtin settlement, and the individuals in the following list purchased individual property on their own.
