

## Table 4: Compilation of Crimean Mennonite Villages Prepared by Tim Janzen

This table is a compilation of known Crimean Mennonite villages **sorted alphabetically**. Villages for which there is more than one spelling of the name are listed by all known spellings.

The data for this table has been gathered from a number of independent sources. These sources include the Deutsches Ausland Institut (DAI) documents from National Archives Microfilm T81607, the *Mennonite Historical Atlas*; *The Mennonite Encyclopedia*; Heinrich Goerz' book, *Mennonite Settlements in Crimea*; Delbert Plett's book, *Saints and Sinners*; the Busau Mennonite Church Records, and Karl Stumpp's map of Crimea.
